



Mod2 Home Theater Speaker System

This is our highest output home theater speaker system. It includes five of our exclusive satellites and our acoustically-matched audiophile quality subwoofer, the Super Eight. The Mod2 is the perfect solution for larger rooms or any situation where higher output for home theater or stereo performance is a priority. The Mod2 satellites are available in Metallic Black Gloss, Pearl White Gloss, Hand Polished Steel (\$200 option) and Hand Antiqued Copper (\$300 option). The Mod2 is also fully customizable, so you may select different colors for your front and rear satellites. These are truly Small Speakers For Smart People, and will outperform many \$3,000+ systems found in retail stores.

The Mod2 is rated at 110W power handling and a nominal impedance of 4 ohms. Due to the efficient design and small size of our custom driver, the Mod2 is compatible with receivers rated at 6-8 ohms. The Mod2 satellites



feature gold binding posts, high-power neodymium magnets and oxygen-free internal wire. They are assembled in the United States by skilled craftspeople with years of experience in electronics assembly. The Mod2 satellites are backed by a five year limited warranty, as well as a 30 day Satisfaction Guarantee.

Subwoofer

Our custom Super Eight subwoofer is acoustically matched to our Mod2 satellites. The Super Eight offers the highest possible performance out of a 12 inch cube and was styled by our in house industrial design team. It features a high quality 150 watt Class A/B amplifier that is conservatively rated to peak at over 400 watts, a super long-throw 8" woofer, and a high-power magnet. The Super Eight plays down to 25hz (28hz at -4dB) and features a max SPL (sound pressure level) of 111dB, which is on par with most high quality subwoofers that have much larger cabinets and drivers. Thus, the subwoofer retains the musicality and tightness that is essential to success (yet lacking in many other systems), while still capable of extremely powerful and deep bass performance.
